- Weingut Pittnauer is located in the wine region of Neusiedlersee. The special microclimate of this district is characterized by Austria's longest hours of sunlight, high humidity and moderate temperatures influenced by the large, shallow lake, the Neusiedlersee.
- The estate is run by the young couple Brigit and Gerhard Pittnauer. The Pittnauer's are considered St. Laurent specialists and their Pinot Noir is one of the best varietal representatives from Austria.

Rose 2009

From the master of St. Laurent comes this complex, elegantly layered Rosé that shows luscious red fruit and thirst quenching citrus that is perfect for a 90-degree day. Also the package (see right) is eye-catching and fun.

Blaufränkisch Klassik 2006

Blaufränkisch is an Austrian grape, comparable to Syrah. Pittnauer's Blaufränkisch is BIG and Bold, loaded with black berries and plum flavors with a spicy finish. Perfect for BBQ or Pizza!

Velvet 2006

An Austrian red blend of Blaufränkisch 60%, Zweigelt 35% and Cabernet Sauvignon 5%. Dark bramble fruit, blackberry and cassis with great tannic structure.

St. Laurent Dorflagen 2008

PINOT NOIR ON STERIODS! St. Laurent is a grape found in Austria and southern Germany that is related to Pinot Noir, but it is much bigger in style than most pinots. Sometimes St. Laurent is compared to a big Central Otago Pinot Noir. The Klassik is a St. Laurent that sees only 6 months in used barriques. Fruit-forward style.
